The Year in Review

2023 was a year of significant growth at ABLE as we finalized and began to implement a five-year strategic plan to expand and enhance our services for people who are blind or otherwise print disabled. The strategic plan builds on the work we have been doing for nearly 60 years. It includes delivering high quality braille, audio, and tactile products to match community demand and need; and, becoming the premier service provider of choice for people who are blind, visually impaired, and print disabled in Milwaukee.

Our team of staff and volunteers produced 14,070 pages of brailled learning materials for students in 2023, including 2,279 tactile diagrams (raised line drawings). Each page that ABLE produced signified another opportunity for blind students to have a level playing field with their sighted peers. We also implemented several action steps from our strategic plan to keep up with growing demand and to minimize turn-around time for brailled educational materials needed in classrooms. In addition, we produced braille materials for the broader community, including programs for the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra and the Marcus Performing Arts Center, and ballots for the Milwaukee County Election Commission.

ABLE continued to meet individual needs for both braille and audio, transcribing items such as cookbooks, a family's collection of favorite hymns, and books about animal care. Materials requested in an audio format for personal use are recorded by a passionate team of in-home volunteer readers, including some who are not based in the Milwaukee area. We are one of the few organizations in the U.S. that still responds to these individual requests.

Audiobooks produced in the ABLE Sound Center meet the rigorous digital recording standards of the National Library Service. Emphasizing Wisconsin authors, ABLE records books for both children and adults. Each new book is accessible on an ongoing basis. Over the past two years, we strengthened our pool of audio volunteers, adding diversity to the voices narrating our books. A new process for recruiting, screening, and onboarding volunteer narrators—including a more challenging audio audition—has increased the skill level of our volunteers and, in turn, has led to efficiencies in book production. In 2023 we produced 73 audiobooks, and books recorded by ABLE circulated over 12,000 times. Both were new records for us!

In addition to books, ABLE produced other audio resources that help blind and print disabled people participate more fully in community life, including schedules for Summerfest, the Wisconsin State Fair and Irish Fest, as well as a monthly recording of *Milwaukee Magazine*.

We are so grateful for the longstanding commitment of all who contribute to ABLE, in so many ways. Working together, we can enhance literacy, dignity, productivity and independence for people in our community who are blind, visually impaired, or print disabled.
